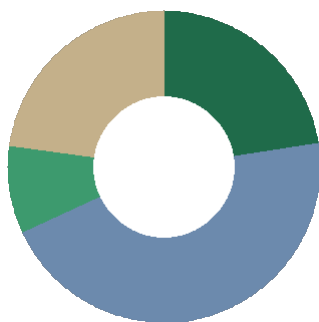

Day 1-3

- Define core features: user input for story, characters, plot points; AI generation; chapter display.

- Register domain name and set up initial project workspace.

Day 4-7

- Build basic user authentication and profile management on no-code platform.
- Design user interface for story input form and generated chapter display.
- Create a simple landing page explaining the service.

Day 8-11

- Integrate selected AI API for text generation based on user prompts.
- Develop backend logic for processing user input into AI prompts and storing generated chapters.
- Set up subscription tiers and integrate a payment gateway (e.g., Stripe).

Day 12-14

- Thoroughly test AI generation quality, user flow, and subscription process.
- Refine AI prompts for better output and user experience.
- Prepare launch content, marketing copy, and a basic user guide.

🎯 Week-one goal

Launch a basic landing page and gather 20 email sign-ups of interested users.

⚠️ Watch-outs

- Risk: AI output quality inconsistent or unengaging. Fix: Implement robust prompt engineering, allow user feedback on generations, and offer regeneration options.
- Risk: Potential copyright concerns when 'extending famous books'. Fix: Clearly state the service is for fan-fiction/inspiration, disclaim official affiliation, and encourage users to focus on original ideas or public domain works.
- Risk: Difficulty attracting initial subscribers. Fix: Offer a limited free trial, engage in targeted communities (e.g., writing forums, fan groups), and showcase compelling AI-generated examples.
